The submission period is from April 20 to May 22, 2009. The top three entries will win gift certificates to Acorn Naturalists (first place: \$150 gift certificate, second place: \$100 gift certificate and third place: \$50 gift certificate.)

When submitting your photos to the contest, be sure to have all individuals in the photographs sign our [release form](#). This form is required in order for your photo to be eligible for the Photo Blog Contest. Parent signatures are required for minors.

All contest participants must be at least 18 years old, residents of the U.S., affiliated with an organization which provides K-12 educational programs and meet all eligibility requirements.
